

Annual Meeting

THE Annual Meeting of the Society was held in the Martin Hall on 26th May, 1967, about 50 members and their friends being present. The Rev. Thomas H. Keir, D.D., President, was in the Chair, and welcomed visitors from overseas.

Members rose to receive the Moderator of the General Assembly, the Right Reverend W. Roy Sanderson, D.D., who, in a brief address to the meeting, referred to his long connection with the Society and conveyed his good wishes for its welfare.

Reference was made to the passing of Mr W. D. Leask, who had been a faithful member of Council for many years.

Reports showed the circulation of the Annual as 1186 copies, including the Societies overseas, a debit balance of £23 in the General Fund and the sum of £323 in the Centenary Fund. It was also intimated that the Council had appointed as Editor of the Annual, the Rev. Ian A. Moir, M.A., B.D., Ph.D., Lecturer in Christian Origins at New College. Dr. Moir, being present, received the thanks and best wishes of the Society.

The speaker on this occasion was the Rev. Professor J. G. Davies, D.D., of the Department of Theology in the University of Birmingham. There is no doubt that his paper on "Reality in Worship", original and provocative in its content, aroused many of those present to do some fresh thinking, as clearly it was intended to do. At the close, Professor Whyte proposed a vote of thanks which was warmly accorded to Professor Davies.
