

THE CHURCH SERVICE SOCIETY NOTES

Annual Meeting

There was an attendance of about 60 members and friends at the Annual Meeting of the Society held on 25th May 1978 in Greyfriars Kirk House, Edinburgh. The President, the Rev. A. K. Robertson, B.D., Ph.D., was in the Chair.

The meeting rose to receive the Right Reverend the Moderator, Dr P. P. Brodie, who was accompanied by Mrs Brodie, members of his family, and his Chaplain. Dr Brodie briefly addressed the meeting, expressing his appreciation of the Society's role in the Church and conveying his good wishes for its work and witness.

Dr Robertson delivered his Presidential Address on "The Individual Cup: its use at Holy Communion", after which, a hearty vote of thanks, on the call of Dr Loudon, expressed the gratitude of all present.

The Secretary's report recorded further developments in the Society's Library in the South West Loft at Greyfriars, including the appointment of Mrs Sybil Brownlee as Librarian. Attention was drawn to the publishing crisis and the urgent need for more members, in order to achieve an increased circulation of *Liturgical Review*.

The Treasurer's statement showed a small credit balance in the General Fund (after taking into account liability for the cost of the journal), and, in the Centenary Fund, a credit balance of £155.

The Rev. Professor J. K. S. Reid, C.B.E., D.D., was unanimously elected as President for the ensuing two years and installed in office. The Rev. A. Stewart Todd was elected as Vice-President, and the Secretary and Treasurer were continued in office. The Council were re-elected, with the addition of the Rev. Professor J. B. Torrance, Aberdeen, the Rev. Dr W. J. Morris, Glasgow, the Rev. K. G. Hughes, Prestonkirk, and Mr Harvey Cruickshank, Perth.
